

# **Peace Poster Information**

Just a reminder: If your club plans to participate in the 2014-2015 Peace Poster contest, Peace Poster kits need to be ordered now. Delivery usually takes 3 - 4 weeks. The club Peace Poster chairperson may order one or more kits from Lions International 630-571-5466. You must purchase a separate kit for each poster submitted for judging to District 11A2. Each kit contains a "winner's information sticker" that needs to be attached to the back of the "winner"s poster" from your club. This "sticker" must be an original and may not be copied. If your club plans to submit one poster for judging by the District, then you only need to purchase one kit. A Peace Poster kit costs \$11.95 plus shipping. By ordering your kit now, you will be ready to contact your local school or youth group in August when the teachers return for the new school year. Teachers usually need 6-8 weeks for the students to complete the project.

All winning posters must be delivered to the District Governor by Nov. 1 for judging. This year's Peace Poster theme is "Peace, Love, & Understanding".




